Background

80% of all land in Uganda is held under unregistered customary tenure. Only 2% of this customary land is centrally registered.

According to the government, freehold tenure will guarantee people's land rights and also improve investment on land. However, many people fear that registering customary land could favour those with money buying up all the land, leaving citizens landless.


